During our recent Stewardship Campaign here at St. Hilary Church, we had several inquiries regarding the possibility of online giving for the Treasure component of the Stewardship commitment. After several months of researching this possibility, we are happy to announce that we are introducing the *Faith Direct* program which will enable you to manage your Stewardship of Treasure online and enable you to make contributions from either your checking account or credit card.

I hope you will give this program careful consideration for your Sunday offertory and second collections. **To enroll online click on the Faith Direct logo below and use our parish code OH247.** *Faith Direct* will provide you with personalized offertory cards you may choose to place in the offertory basket as a visible sign of your support. You should also know that there is neither cost to you to make your donations through this program.



One of the great advantages of Faith Direct is convenience. Once you set up your account, you can determine your Stewardship of Treasure commitment based on how you want withdrawals to be made, which second collections you wish to contribute to, as well as which special collections you wish to donate to, such as St. Vincent de Paul or the St. Hilary Foundation. You can then manage or update your account at any time at your convenience. Faith Direct will also send you a detailed statement of your donations at the end of the year for tax purposes.

I invite you to consider signing up for Faith Direct at your earliest convenience. This program is recommended by our parish Stewardship Committee with the support of the Finance Council and looks to be a great tool now at our disposal for financially supporting St. Hilary Parish and our many ministries in a way that is convenient, secure, and future oriented.
