## REFLECTING ON THE SCRIPTURES

Again in today's gospel we hear part of Jesus' "bread of life" discourse from John 6. Because Jesus' presence in the Eucharist is mystery there is no adequate answer to the question posed in the gospel, "How can this man give us his flesh to eat?" Yet, we believe. "My flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink," we hear. And what is the result of food and drink? It becomes a real part of us, cell by cell. So, too this heavenly food, has the power to permeate us, to bring about in us the new life Jesus promises. When speaking of this Bread of Life, St. Augustine tells us to "become what you eat." Reflect on your own life. What changes might such intimacy, being one with the Lord, cause in you if you allow it?

Our second reading urges us to "give thanks always and for everything". "Thanksgiving" is the meaning of the word "Eucharist". How might that understanding color your post-communion prayer?

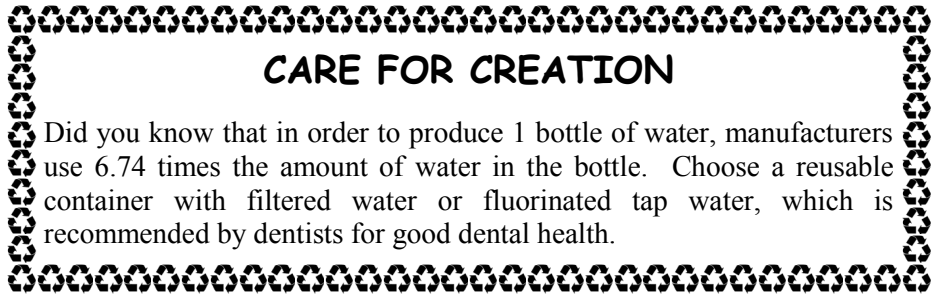
